**Summary**

Abstract: Collection of papers of Southern Baptist minister from Virginia. Collection of thirty-three documents, mostly correspondence to family members. Letters relate to family news, church events, and war activities during the Civil War.

**Biographical Sketch**

Southern Baptist minister from Virginia. Born in Isle of Wight, VA in 1808. He served as a Methodist circuit rider in Western Tennessee and then as pastor of the Churchland Baptist Church in Norfolk County, VA. Elected as vice-president of the Southern Baptist Convention in 1885. On August 24, 1882 he received an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree. He died on December 9, 1885 and buried at the Churchland Baptist Church cemetery between Suffolk and Portsmouth, Virginia. Jones had served as pastor at the Churchland Baptist Church.<sup>1</sup>

**Description**

Collection consists of 33 documents, mostly correspondence to family members. Letters relate to family news, church events, and war activities during the Civil War. Also includes ordination certificate, a marriage certificate and letters from the Shoulders Hill Baptist Church to the Portsmouth Baptist Association in Virginia. Includes letters to his first wife Lanetta and his second wife Susan Deans.
