Summary

Main Entry: Davis Collier Woolley Collection

Date Span: 1896, 1970.

Abstract: Southern Baptist minister who served as pastor, Baptist Student Union director, and executive of the Historical Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention. The collection contains both official and personal papers, including biographical materials, church records, clippings, correspondence, diaries, diplomas, minutes, pamphlets, posters, reports, and sermons. Official papers document the career of Woolley including his time as a student at Howard College, Birmingham, Alabama (now Samford University) and Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. Materials also deal with his positions as Director of the Extension Division, Howard College and Secretary of the Alabama State Baptist Student Union. Other material includes church records and sermons related to his pastorates at First Baptist Church, Palatka, Florida, Waddy Baptist Church, Waddy, Kentucky, and Zion Baptist Church, Henderson County, Kentucky. Personal papers are comprised mostly of correspondence between Dr. Woolley and his family.

Biographical Sketch

Davis Collier Woolley was Executive Secretary of the Historical Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention from 1959, 1970. As the second director of the Commission, he helped the agency develop and promoted the use of its materials. Before accepting the Historical Commission position, he was the Director of the Howard College Extension Department in Birmingham, Alabama. From 1940 – 1942, he worked as Secretary for the Alabama State Baptist Student Union, and before then as Student Director of the Baptist Student Union, First Baptist Church, Auburn, Alabama. Dr. Woolley also served as pastor of First Baptist Church, Palatka, Florida, Waddy Baptist Church, Waddy, Kentucky, and Zion Baptist Church, Henderson County, Kentucky.

Woolley researched, wrote about, and promoted Baptist history throughout his career. He authored two books, *Champions of Religious Freedom* (BV741.W69 1964) and *Guide for Writing the History of a Church* (BR138.W6 1969). With the creation of Baptist History and Heritage in 1965, Dr. Woolley assumed the position of editor. Other works he edited were *Baptist Advance* (Broadman Press, 1964) and *Encyclopedia of Southern*

Baptists, Volume III (Broadman Press, 1971). He was Chairman of the Southern Baptist Convention's Inter-Agency Council from 1961, 1963 and continued to serve on the council until 1970. He was vice-president of the Alabama Baptist Historical Society from 1958, 1959. Dr. Woolley received his Bachelor of Arts from Howard College and his Master of Theology and Doctor of Theology from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky.

Davis Woolley was born September 22, 1908 in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and had seven siblings: David, Clifton, Thomas, Hermione, Mary, Ruth, and Nancy. The Woolley family moved around Alabama until settling in Montgomery, where Dr. Woolley graduated from County High School in 1925. He married Kate Fristoe Wilkins from Greensboro, North Carolina (b. December 2, 1913, d. 2008) June 30, 1942. The couple had five children: James, Katherine, Mary, John, and Nancy. Dr. Woolley died January 15, 1971 in Nashville, Tennessee.

Scope and Content Note

The Davis Collier Woolley Collection (1896, 1970) contains 19 linear feet of material in thirty-six boxes, including biographical material, church records, clippings, correspondence, diaries, diplomas, minutes, pamphlets, posters, reports, and sermons. There are also some artifacts: convention buttons, conference badges, and medallions from Howard College and Samford University. Material is arranged alphabetically and then chronologically.

The collection includes both official and personal papers. Official papers document Dr. Woolley's career from his time as a student at Howard College in Birmingham, Alabama, continuing through his work as Executive Secretary of the Southern Baptist Convention Historical Commission. Researchers should note that the collection contains only a small amount of material related to his tenure at the Historical Commission, with the bulk of the collection focused on his earlier work.

Sermons are arranged alphabetically by title. Other church material includes newsletters, bulletins, minutes, and reports from Dr. Woolley's pastorates, including Zion Baptist Church, Henderson County, Kentucky, Waddy Baptist Church, Waddy, Kentucky, and First Baptist Church, Palatka, Florida. Baptist leaders with whom Dr. Woolley corresponded were: Guy Bellamy, John H. Buchanan, Norman W. Cox, Gaines S. Dobbins, John Maguire, Chester L. Quarles, and John R. Sampey.

Dr. Woolley wrote extensively, and the collection contains many of his articles, essays, sermons, and preparatory material he collected, such as clippings and pamphlets. A significant portion of the collection relates to Baptist history – in particular, Alabama Baptist history – comprised mainly of clippings, biographical files, and Dr. Woolley's work in the Alabama Baptist Historical Society. Subjects covered in this collection include: alcohol and temperance, church and state, race relations, religion in higher education, and student work.

Personal papers consist mainly of family correspondence. The Woolley family, including Dr. Woolley's siblings – Clifton, Thomas, Hermione, Mary, Ruth and Nancy, and their respective spouses and children – participated in family chain letters that informed the rest of the family about daily activities and events from 1945, 1970. Though uneven in volume throughout the decades, the letters detail genealogical research about the family and their ancestors. Other personal material includes correspondence, clippings, and diaries.

Additional oversized diplomas from Howard College and convention courses, photographs from Ridgecrest in 1939, posters about the Alabama Baptist Cooperative Program (1959), and the Alabama Woman's Missionary Union Associational Missions Offering (1956) are located in the Archival Map Case, Drawer 5.

Researchers should note that Dr. Woolley's obituary, correspondence to Mrs. Woolley, during his illness and after he died, and tribute letters from other members of the Inter-Agency Council can be found on MF 3536 in the Archives. Please notice that item numbers stamped on a majority of the material reflects an earlier arrangement and are no longer accurate.
