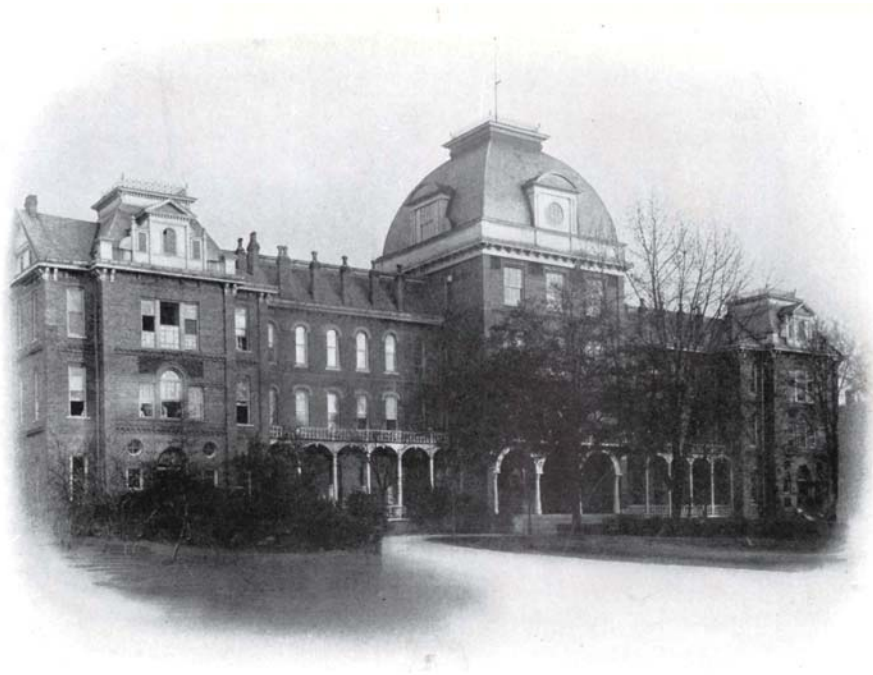

Summary

Main Entry: Southern Baptist Convention. Education Commission Records

Date Span: 1927 – 1984

Abstract: The Education Commission was an agency of the Southern Baptist Convention temporarily established by action of the Convention in 1915, changed to permanent status in 1917, replaced by the Education Board in 1919, and re-established in 1928. The Commission was dissolved in 1997. The Commission liaison between the Southern Baptist Convention and Baptist Colleges, all of which are owned and operated by individual Baptist state conventions. The collection contains official correspondence, business and fiduciary papers, personnel records, minutes of meetings, and documentation of auxiliary educational associations.

Historical, Biographical Note

The Education Commission Papers is the official collection of correspondence, business, fiduciary, and personnel records, minutes of meetings, and documentation of auxiliary organizations of an agency of the Southern Baptist Convention. General records exist from about 1927 through 1984. They document the administrations of full-time chief executives of the Commission, including those of Dr. Richard Orrin Cornett, the first full-time executive; Dr. Raybun Brantley; Dr. Benjamin C. Fisher; and Dr. Arthur L. Walker.

The Education Commission was temporarily established by action of the Convention in 1915, changed to permanent status in 1917, replaced by the Education Board in 1919, and re-established in 1928. Records do not exist until about 1927, the time of the death of Mrs. Ida Reed Opdyke of Jamestown, New York, who bequeathed 49% of her extensive estate to the Southern Baptist Convention for the education of mountain youth as a memorial to her late daughter, Dorthea Van Dusen Okdyke. Dr. Hight C. Moore represented the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention in litigation brought by the Opdyke son in an

effort to break the will. The move was unsuccessful and was finally settled in the Convention's favor by the New York Supreme Court in 1932.

The Commission was dissolved by Convention action in 1997. The function of the Commission was assumed by the International Association of Baptist Colleges and Universities. The Association continued to publish the *Southern Baptist Educator*, which was renamed, *Baptist Educator*.

Scope and Content Notes

Much documentation exists concerning the administration of the Opkyke Fund, the struggle of Baptist schools to survive during the depression, their rebuilding after World War II, Civil Rights and anti-discrimination legislation, confrontation with enlightened and empowered student groups, reaction to the Viet Nam War, the struggle for accreditation and enhanced institutional status, and the fine tuning academic programs to meet modern needs. Such activity resulted in self-studies, national conferences, and workshops.

Considerable attention is given to the formation and development of sub-associations, ancillary, and support groups. Extensive holdings represent the American Baptist Theological Seminary, Association of Baptist Professors of Religion, Association of Southern Baptist Colleges and Schools, BAPTIST EDUCATION STUDY TASK (Baptist Education Study Task), and The Center for Constitutional Studies at Mercer University.

The collection contains personal correspondence from: Jimmy Carter, Betty Ford, Mark Hatfield, Orrin Hatch, Jesse Helms, Richard Fulton, Robin Beard, James Quillen, J. Earl McGrath, and Elton Trueblood, among others. Correspondence is also included from many prominent Baptist leaders of the time: George W. Truett, Gaines S. Dobbins, Austin Crouch, Hight C. Moore, Duke K. McCall, Porter Ruth, Albert McClellan, W. A. Criswell, J. W. Storer, James L. Sullivan, Clifton J. Allen, H. Franklin Paschall, Herschel Hobbs, Owen Cooper, Baker James Cauthen, Raymond M. Rigdon, Kendall Berry, Lynn E. May, Jr., and others.

The collection is arranged in alphabetical order by folder title. The major series within the papers – Correspondence, The Opdyke Fund, and The American Baptist Theological Seminary – are arranged chronologically within the series. Additions are expected to the collection.

The collection comprises 29 boxes and 36.5 cubic feet of material. Some files related to the early work of the Education Commission and the Opdyke Scholarship Fund are located on one reel of 16 mm negative microfilm, MF 2142.
