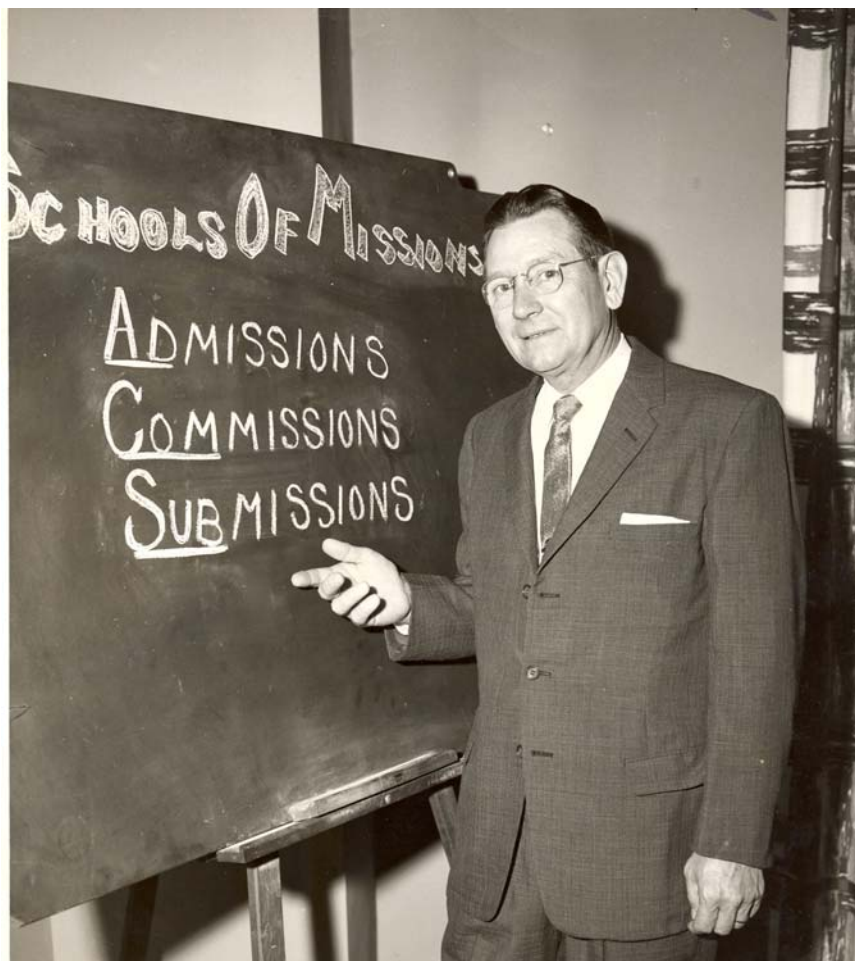

### **Summary**

Main Entry: Southern Baptist Convention. Home Mission Board Department of Missionary Education Collection

Date Span: 1928 – 1985

Abstract: The Department of Missionary Education of the Home Mission Board promoted schools of missions, later called world missions conferences. Schools of missions were a missionary education program in which an entire church participated in graded missions classes for a week. Part of the program was talks given by current missionaries in the field. The collection includes articles, biographical information, clippings, correspondence, minutes, reports, and sermons. Two series follow the tenure of Lewis W. Martin and Kenneth as Director of the Department.

### **Historical Sketch**

The Home Mission Board's Department of Missionary Education became part of the Division of Education and Promotion in 1959. Originally the Schools of Missions Department, the Department of Missionary Education worked with churches to put on schools of missions, which were missionary education programs in which the entire church participated in graded missions classes followed by a general assembly and heard messages from foreign missionaries. The Home Mission Board promoted schools of missions with the Foreign Mission Board and state conventions along with support from the Woman's Missionary Union and the Brotherhood Commission. The objectives of the schools of missions were: to stimulate greater personal soul-winning, encourage churches to organize new missions, inspire dedicated prayer for missions, increase financial contributions to missions, and increase commitments to mission's service. Schools of missions were called several different names such as world missions week and world missions institute before officially changing to world missions conferences in 1968 when the Department of Missionary Education became part of newly created Promotion Department. World missions conferences continued to operate as part of the Promotion Department until the department was disbanded in a 1988 reorganization. Duties performed by the Department were assigned to the newly created Human Resources

Division, Public Relations Office in the Executive Office, and the Materials Production Department of the Communication Division.

Lewis W. Martin led the Schools of Missions Department from 1943 through its absorption by the Division of Education and Promotion in 1959 until 1965. Succeeded by Kenneth Day, Martin retired and served several churches as interim pastor including Pukalani Baptist Church in Maui, Hawaii from 1967-1968. After the Department of Missionary Education became the Promotion Department, Mr. Day served as director until 1975 when he became the director of the Communication Division, formerly the Division of Education and Promotion.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The Home Mission Board Department of Missionary Education Collection (1928-1985) contains eleven linear feet of material in eleven record center boxes. Materials include articles, biographical information, clippings, correspondence, minutes, reports and sermons.

The collection has two series that follow the tenure of Lewis W. Martin and Kenneth Day as director of the Department. Additionally, there are files from two of Mr. Day's secretaries, Ernestine Adams and Ella Keller, which are part Mr. Day's series and are arranged alphabetically. Materials from the collection focus primarily on schools of missions later called world missions conferences. The schools of missions materials include planning documents such as the *Guidebook* published by the Department to help facilitate the program's organization. Other topics include Hawaii, mountain missions, and revivals. Correspondence within the collection is from various missionaries with the Foreign Mission Board, who participated in world missions conferences, and other Home Mission Board staff members such as Joe W. Burton and Arthur Rutledge.
