Date Span: 1965 – 1990

Abstract: The Christian Social Ministries Department began in 1966 and combined existing social work programs operated by the Home Mission Board. Seeking to use these programs to express Christian love and provide a Christian witness through special mission actions, the Department added new programs and then folded into the Church and Community Ministries Department. The Christian Social Ministries Department Collection contains the files of four administrative staff: Clovis A. Brantley, Mildred Blankenship, Mary Kuhnle, and Gerry Hutchinson. Most of the material is correspondence, with some articles, clippings, pamphlets, and reports.

Historical Sketch

The Christian Social Ministries Department of the Home Mission Board began in 1966 and combined the work of Good Will centers, juvenile rehabilitation, literacy missions, and migrant missions with a new program of disaster relief. Through social work efforts in these agencies, the Department created evangelism opportunities that fulfilled the Department's dual objective: to express Christian love and to provide a Christian witness through special mission's actions.

Paul R. Adkins served as the first executive secretary from 1968 – 1969, and T. E. Carter succeeded Mr. Adkins until 1971, when Mr. Adkins resumed the position. In 1971, the department underwent an organizational restructuring that expanded the five original programs with the following new subprograms: domestic hunger, ministry with single persons, alcohol and drug abusers, Sellers Baptist Home and Adoption Center, church and community ministries, criminal justice system, and blind ministry and handicapped persons. The department divided these programs among the director, associate director and four assistant directors, and two national consultants. People serving in the Department during the 1970s and 1980s included: Paul Adkins, Charles McCullin, Clovis A. Brantley, Mildred Blankenship, Harold Wilcox, Beverly Hammack, James Barber,

Cecil Etheredge, Sandra Hill, Nathan Porter, Lillian Isaacs, Mary Dan Kuhnle, Gerry Hutchinson, and Lester Meriwether.

In a 1985 restructuring of the Missions Section of the Home Mission Board, the Christian Social Ministries Department was incorporated into the Church and Community Ministries Department. The administration of the Baptist centers remained under the direction of the department, renamed the Christian Social Ministries Centers Department. These departments fell under the Missions Ministries Division led by M. Wendell Belew, whom Beverly Hammack succeeded in 1989. The Christian Social Ministries Centers Department combined with the Church and Community Ministries Department in a 1988 reorganization. In 1989, Paul R. Adkins became Vice President of the Ministry Section of the Home Mission Board.

Scope and Content Note

The Christian Social Ministries Department Collection contains twelve linear feet of material in twelve record center boxes. Most of the material in the collection is correspondence, with some articles, clippings, publications, and reports throughout.

The collection has the papers of four administrative staff members: Clovis A. Brantley, Mildred Blankenship, Mary Kuhnle, and Gerry Hutchinson – with the majority of the collection from Mr. Brantley and Ms. Blankenship. Mr. Brantley served as Associate Secretary of the Department from 1971 – 1977 after working as an Assistant Secretary from 1969 – 1971. Ms. Blankenship was Assistant Director for Literacy Missions from 1966 – 1989. Ms. Kuhnle was the Director of the Sellers Baptist Home and Adoption Center in New Orleans, Louisiana from 1976 – 1991. Mr. Hutchinson was the Manager of the Church and Community Ministries Department in the early 1990s.

The correspondence in the collection deals with the day-to-day activities of the Department. Topics covered relate to the programs administered by the Department including: Baptist centers, disaster relief, literacy missions, juvenile rehabilitation, migrant missions, domestic hunger, ministry with single persons, alcohol and drug abusers, Sellers Baptist Home and Adoption Center, church and community ministries, criminal justice system, and blind ministry and handicapped persons.
