Summary

Main Entry: Marjorie Moore Armstrong Collection

Date Span: 1932 – 1989

Abstract: Collection contains files relating to the journalistic career of Marjorie Moore Armstrong, a prominent Baptist writer and speaker. It includes many articles and pamphlets written by Mrs. Armstrong. In addition, the collection contains information relating to foreign missions, Baptists of the world and missionary materials relating to young people and women.

Biographical Sketch

Southern Baptist journalist, author and missionary. Marjorie Moore was born in Athens, Georgia in 1912. After graduating high school, she attended Converse College in Spartanburg, S.C. Following completion of coursework at the W.M.U. Training school in 1935, Ms. Moore became an assistant editor of *The Baptist Student*. In 1942, Ms. Moore received the post of managing editor of *The Commission*. During this time, she began attending the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University, graduating in 1950.

In 1949, Ms. Moore married Senator O.K. Armstrong of Missouri. The new Mrs. Armstrong became a dedicated wife and stepmother to Armstrong's five children. She did not abandon her journalistic pursuits, however. Mrs. Armstrong took up freelance writing to various Baptist publications including the *YWA Window*, *Ambassador Life*, *Baptist Young People* and *The Baptist Student*. From 1954 – 1956, Mrs. Armstrong served as the co-editor of *The Baptist World*. Husband and wife collaborated on several books dealing with Baptist history and Baptists throughout the world. Mrs. Armstrong was active in many church and denominational activities, including the Woman's Missionary Union. She was a frequent speaker at Baptist gatherings across the country. Following her husband's death in 1987, Mrs. Armstrong continued to write for a variety of publications.

Marjorie Moore Armstrong died on December 18, 2002.

Scope and Content Note

The Marjorie Moore Armstrong Collection (20 linear ft.) consists of articles, manuscripts, correspondence, minutes, notes and programs. The material primarily covers Armstrong's career

as a journalist, author and missionary. The correspondence files focuses on family letters, missionary letter and correspondence related to her writings. The collection focuses on the role of women in Baptist life, home missions, foreign missions and Baptist history. In addition the collection includes correspondence with publishers, editors, missionaries and family. Almost half of the collection consists of Armstrong's writings.

The major topics and issues included in the papers are: home missions, foreign missions, journalism, Baptist history, women and youth in church work, and Christianity and politics.
