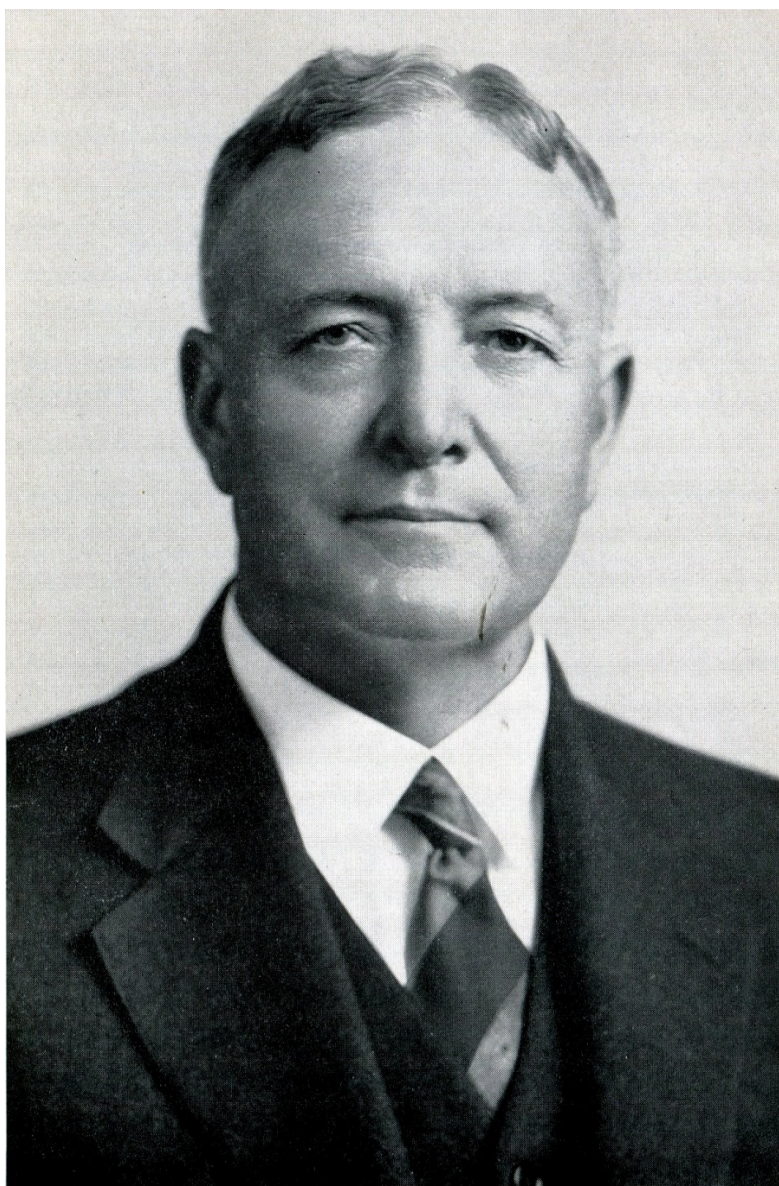

Summary

Main Entry: Walter Oliver Lewis Collection

Date Span: 1921 – 1939

Abstract: Lewis served as European representative of the American Baptist Foreign Mission Society from 1922-1939. In 1939 he became General Secretary of the Baptist World Alliance, a position he held until 1950. He was Associate Secretary of the BWA from 1950-1955. The papers include correspondence, reports, and information on Baptists in Russia under communism from 1921-1939, and the work of the Baptist World Alliance in Russia. The papers are divided into the following sections. 1. Russia - General Files, 1921-1936 -- 2. Russia- Seminary, 1912-1929 -- 3. Russian Relief, 1921-1924 -- 4. Odessa Trip, 1923-1924 -- 5. Russian Famine, 1933-1935 -- 6. Ivan Stepanovich Prokhanov, 1924-1930 -- 7. William Fetler Case, 1922-1930 -- 8. Latvia, 1929-1937 -- 9. Estonia, 1928-1939.

Biographical Sketch

Walter Oliver Lewis was born in Stanberry, Missouri on February 22, 1877. He earned a B.A. degree from William Jewell College, Liberty, Missouri, in 1898. In 1904, he received a Th.D. Degree from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, and in 1908, he earned a Ph.D. degree from the University of Erlangen, Germany.

Lewis was ordained as a Southern Baptist pastor in 1897. Until 1910, he served as pastor for the following churches: West Park Church, St. Louis, Missouri; Wyatt Park Church, St. Joseph, Missouri; and Compton Heights Church, St. Louis. From 1910-1922, he served as Professor of Philosophy and Religion at William Jewell College.

Lewis served as the European representative of the American Baptist Foreign Mission Society from 1922-1939. In 1939, he became General Secretary of the Baptist World Alliance, a position he held until 1950. He was Associate Secretary of the Alliance from 1950-1955 and died in August 1965.

Scope and Content Note

The Walter Oliver Lewis Collection (2 microfilm reels) consists of diaries, appointment calendars, lectures, essays, sermons, correspondence, and working files related to twentieth century global Baptist work. The material related to Baptists in Russia, Latvia, and Estonia. The collection also documents relief effort in Russia in the 1920s and 1930s by the Baptist World Alliance. The original papers are located in Franklin Trask Library at Andover Newton Theological School. A special thanks to the Trask Library for their inventory to the Lewis Papers that greatly assisted in the development of this finding aid.
