### Summary

Main Entry: Student Summer Missions Collection

Date Span: 1947 – 1959

Abstract: Collection contains William Hall Preston's papers and documents the Summer Missions Program's development and implementation from 1947 – 1959 at the Sunday School Board's Student Department. Preston served as Associate Secretary for the Student Department at the Sunday School Board of the Southern Baptist Convention. Included are correspondence, applications with photographs, reports on the program, and questionnaires answered by both students and the missionaries with whom they worked.

### Historical Sketch

William Hall Preston served as Associate Secretary for the Student Department (later the National Student Ministries Department) of the Southern Baptist Sunday School Board from 1927 – 1964. He helped develop and coordinate the Baptist Student Union's Student Summer Missions Program. Preston authored three books, *God Has Something Great for You*, *Church Loyalty*, and *Fathers are Special, Too*. Before working at the Sunday School Board, Preston was president of Hall-Moody Junior College (later the University of Tennessee-Martin) and was Training Union Secretary for the Tennessee Baptist Convention. Preston was born February 22, 1896 in Blackwood, New Jersey, and died October 20, 1987.

Preston helped coordinate the Sunday School Board's Student Summer Missions Program along with the Student Summer Missions Program (1942 – 1969) sponsored by the Home Mission Board's Department of Special Mission Ministries.<sup>1</sup> He also worked with the Foreign Mission Board for the Program. Student missionaries worked in states such as Washington, Oregon, Texas, and New Mexico, and countries including Italy, Jamaica, Ghana, and Cuba. The Sunday School Board's Program gave students practical experience on the mission field and provided training for leading Vacation Bible School.

The Missions Program continued through the 1960s under the Special Missions Ministries Department until it transitioned to the Christian Service Corps in 1970.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The Student Summer Missions Collection contains William Hall Preston's papers and documents the Summer Missions Program's development and implementation from 1947 – 1959 at the Sunday School Board's Student Department. The Collection has 6.5 linear feet of material in 13 document boxes and includes correspondence, applications with photographs, reports on the program, and questionnaires answered by both students and the missionaries with whom they worked.

The Collection is arranged chronologically and then alphabetically by folder title. Much of the correspondence is accounts from student missionaries sent to Preston. Some correspondence covers administrative matters and relates primarily to coordination efforts between the Sunday School Board and the Home and Foreign Mission Boards. In their applications, students discussed why they wanted to serve, and some included detailed autobiographies. While some students had ministry experience, many came with various backgrounds such as science and foreign language.

Other collections that might be useful for researchers are the Baptist Student Union Collection (AR 33), the Sunday School Department Collection (AR 565), and the Home Mission Board Executive Office Files (AR 631-3).
