I. Description

The Russian Evangelical Archives Collection consists of scanned materials on five compact discs which have been printed, placed in acid-free folders, and boxed into 27 document boxes (13.5 linear ft.). Materials on the cd's were originally scanned from the Russian Evangelical Archives in Moscow. They were first donated to Dr. Albert Wardin, Jr. of Nashville, who in turn donated the discs to the SBHLA in 2007.

Materials in this collection are in Russian. Folder titles and subsequent information were provided by Dr. Albert Wardin. The collection has no restrictions and is open for research.
