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Summary

Main Entry: Resumes of the Significant Events in the Southern Baptist Convention Collection

Date Span: 1812-1972

Abstract: The collection includes resumes of Southern Baptist Convention agencies and programs prepared by the Historical Commission in the early 1960's. Updates for some agency's resumes were done in 1972.

Historical Note

In the early 1960's the Historical Commission, in cooperation with the Executive Committee, prepared histories of various agencies, organizations, or institutions and their activities in the Southern Baptist Convention for use by the Executive Committee. In these resumes, events in the entity's past are arranged chronologically by year covering the events surrounding these entities' formation into the late 1950's and early 1960's. Many also contain notes marking specific aspects of an organization, so that one could trace that particular activity through the organization's history. Most information in these resumes is taken from the Southern Baptist Convention annuals.

Scope and Content Note

Each folder contains the resumes created in 1962-1963 by the Historical Commission and the additions made to them in the 1972, if available. The information was derived from the annuals of the Southern Baptist Convention and certain other sources as indicated. These resumes serve as an extended index to all the actions of the Convention pertaining to the work of that agency or program. The resumes include keys (numbers) to identify the subject area of the section included.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged in alphabetical order by folder title. The resumes are arranged in chronological order.
